He is a Person. He is my best friend. I talk to Him every day." He had never heard this before, and it really struck him so that he thought about it often. We never know the influence we may have on others by sincerely living our own faith.

If you know anyone who might be interested in helping us in this growing mission for the Divine Child Jesus, please pass this newsletter on to them. May God reward you!

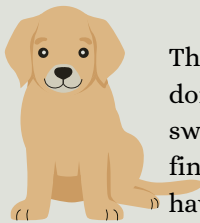
## Prayer to the Sacred Heart
